**Implemented programmes of the 6th EU Framework Programme for Research and Technological Development (6RP):**

NANOMAT – support of research and technological development in small and medium-sized companies in the Czech Republic focused on nanotechnology and new multifunctional materials. The project was realized in 2003 – 2006 by an international consortium of nine members, of which Inova Pro was a member. The engagement of the Czech company Eximet Trafo by the Inova Pro company in the integrated research project 6RP PROFORM was appreciated as the so-called best practice by the European Commission.

TALENT SCOUT – support of research and technological development in small and medium-sized biotechnological companies in the Czech Republic and their integration into the European Research Area. The project was implemented in 2004-2006 by the international consortium formed by twelve members. Inova Pro was one of the members of the project.

STAR NET – support of research and technological development in the field of information technologies and integration of the Czech subjects into the European research projects. The project was implemented in 2005-2007 by the international consortium formed by sixteen members.
